



RATIONALE:

The College will provide a New Zealand educational experience for a limited number of International Students and in doing so will promote further opportunities at our College for people from diverse cultures to work alongside each other and enhance their understanding of each other's culture. Full compliance with Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice 2016 [The Code] is a key aspect of our International Students programme.

PURPOSE:


1. Increase BDSC revenue to resource quality teaching and learning at BDSC.
2. Foster international understanding and goodwill/co-operation now and in the future.
3. Expand cultural awareness and skills of BDSC students.

GUIDELINES:

1. BDSC will aim to enroll up to a maximum of 9% of College roll each year in the International Fee Paying Students programme.
2. BDSC will recognize and adhere to The Code with respect to all its provisions and requirements.
3. All Policies, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations applying to BDSC in-zone students will apply to International Fee Paying Students except where specific exceptions are documented in the Code of Practice.
4. To control planning and budget cash flow of the international department and how it sustains teaching and learning at the College.
