#### **BALLOT PRIORITIES**

The exact number of Out of Zone placements will depend on the number of applications received from students living in the College home zone.

The Amendment Act 2010 states that:

- Priority 2 must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school
- Priority 3 must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school
- Priority 4 must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school
- Priority 5 must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school

Priority 6 must be given to all other applicants

In situations where the number of applicants for Year 9 exceeds the number of places available for Out of Zone students, selection will be by ballot. If a ballot is required at our College, it will be held on **Wednesday 3 September 2025** and will be supervised by a Justice of the Peace, practising lawyer, or a sworn member of the police. **Due to the college** experiencing continued growth, we cannot determine the number of Out of Zone placements available for Years 10-13 in the 2026 academic year. The number of placements will be checked and reviewed in January 2026. Therefore, the date for a proposed ballot for Years 10-13 will be advertised and all Out of Zone applicants will be emailed the scheduled date of that ballot. If your application has been successful, you will be asked to confirm your acceptance or rejection within 14 days of the date the letter was sent. If you do not respond within the 14 days, the place will be offered to the first person on the waiting list established by the ballot.

# The final deadline for receipt of applications for OUT OF ZONE students is 4pm Wednesday 27 August 2025.

The ballot takes place on Wednesday 3 September 2025.
