Out of Zone Applications for 2020

The exact number of out-of-zone placements will depend on the number of applications received from students living in the College's home zone.

The Education Amendment Act 2010 states that:

- a. First priority must be given to any applicant who is accepted for enrolment in a special programme run by the school (this does not apply to Botany Downs Secondary College)
- b. Second priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school
- c. Third priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a former student of the school
- d. Fourth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school
- e. Fifth priority must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school
- f. Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants.

In situations where the number of applicants for Year 9 exceeds the number of places available for out-of-zone students, selection will be by ballot. If a ballot is required at our College, it will be held on 12 September 2019 and will be supervised by a Justice of the Peace, practising lawyer, or a sworn member of the police. Due to the college experiencing continued growth, we cannot determine the number of out-of-zone placements available for Year 10-13 in the 2020 academic year. The number of placements will be checked and reviewed in January 2020. Therefore, the date for a proposed ballot for Years 10-13 will be advertised and all out-of-zone applicants will be emailed the scheduled date of that ballot. If your application has been successful, you will be asked to confirm your acceptance or rejection within 14 days of the date the letter was sent. If you do not respond within the 14 days, the place will be offered to the first person on the waiting list established by the ballot.

The final deadline for receipt of applications for OUT-OF-ZONE students is Wednesday 4 September 2019.

The ballot takes place on Wednesday 11 September 2019.
