## **Covid-19 Contact Management Pathways**



## **Close Contacts**

ADVICE FOR CLOSE CONTACTS	
Close Contacts must:	<ul> <li>Self-isolate at home for 10 days post exposure, test immediately and on days 5 and 8 post exposure</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Continue to isolate at home until negative day 8 test result received AND 10 days has passed since exposure</li> </ul>
	Be advised by public health when they can return to school / kura, and return to normal life
	<ul> <li>Get an additional test immediately if symptoms develop at any time during the 10 days.</li> <li>Stay at home until negative test result AND until 24 hours after symptoms resolve</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ensure that unvaccinated household members, including children/tamariki, stay at home until the Close Contact receives a negative day 5 test</li> </ul>

**NOTE** that household contacts are managed by public health, and they should follow the advice provided by public health rather than the school.

## **Casual Contacts / General Advice**

ADVICE FOR CASUAL CONTACTS / GENERAL ADVICE FOR PRIMARY AND INTERMEDIATE SCHOOLS OR KURA	
Casual Contacts <b>must</b> :	<ul> <li>Watch for symptoms for 10 days and if any develop, get tested immediately and stay at home/keep child at home until 24 hours after symptoms resolve</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>If you do not have any COVID-19 symptoms, you can continue to attend school/kura</li> </ul>
